GROUPS and RETREATS @ KLIPINNIBOS 2025

We offer rustic, simple and characterful accommodation and spaces, set in a magical pocket of indigenous forest in the mountain grasslands of Mpumalanga, in Schoemanskloof.

Capacity

The maximum number of guests for the overall site is 22 people sharing. To allow for more single sleeping options, a total of 12 is suggested.

Minimum group size: 6 including group host/teacher Minimum 2 night stay.

Accommodation fees:

Below reflects our standard rates. A 10% group accommodation discount will be applied for a 2 night stay. 13% discount for a longer stay.

The Stone House: R460 pppn

Bedding and towels provided, Sleeps 5 singles or 8 if couples sharing.

Layout:

2 ground floor rooms with double beds 1 open loft room with double bed 1 open loft room with 2 single beds Shared toilet and shower

<u>Pretty Belinda glamp cottage:</u> R380pppn Bedding and towels provided, Sleeps 4

Layout:

2 single beds and 2 single mattresses in a mini loft Shared sawdust-compost toilet and shower.

Safari tents: Sleeps 10 (mattress and fitted sheet provided, bring your own bedding)

5 x 2 sleeper tents @ R280pppn

Shared camp wood fired shower and compost-sawdust toilet

The personal accommodation fee for a total of one teacher (or the client) is offered for free.

To secure a booking, 50% deposit will be made of the total cost for the number of guests (including catering where that is requested)

The balance should be paid up 14 days before the retreat start date. Failure to do so can result in KLIPINNIBOS cancelling the booking and the deposit will be forfeited.

Catering

We can cater with a simple, wholesome, healthy menu for groups up to 12 people. Quotation sent upon request.

Spaces, Areas and Facilities

Forest House yoga pavilion Infinity Forest stroll and sitspots Hiking Tail to the grassland Labyrinth

Stone House veranda and kitchen (available only if Stone House is used for accommodation)

Camp kitchen

Fire wood (Enough supplied for 2 nights standard fire making)

Offerings

Guided educational nature walk and hike of the farm at a fee of R50 per person.

Night hikes for sunset views and star gazing on the mountain can be organised at the same fee, weather permitting. No night walking may be undertaken without a Klipinnibos staff member present. This needs to be booked prior to the event.

Guidelines

We request that guests arrive after 11 am on the booked arrival date and are expected to leave by 14:00 am at the latest on the departure date.

The client will determine the specific room assignments for their group members.

The client will provide Klipinnibos with each guest/retreatants' name, cell phone number and next of kin number, as well as dietary requirements if catering is required (i.e. gluten free / food allergies), and their signed indemnity forms 14 days prior to the retreat start date.

To support the smooth running of the space, we ask that all guests help with a few simple chores like washing up, and keeping the communal areas and the bathroom tidy.

Contributing in this way helps support the cultivation of community within the retreat/gathering.

We ask that noise levels be kept down after 10PM, unless a later time is specifically requested by the client and agreed to by us.

Wifi access is limited to cases of emergency or logistical needs and can be provided to the organiser/client for their exclusive use upon prior request. The farm generally has good MTN and CELL C 4G/LTE signal.

Deposit and Payment:

A 50% deposit is required at the time of booking. Balance needs to be paid 14 days before the retreat start date.

Cancellation Policy:

- For bookings cancelled by the client within 30 days of the start of the retreat, a full refund will be granted less R150 admin fee.
- 29 15 days 30% of the deposit/payment is forfeited.
- 14 0 days, the full deposit/payment is forfeited.
- In the case of exceptional circumstances*, the deposit/payment from the client can be rolled over to a future date for the retreat, or refunded.

*Exceptional circumstances include a death of a family member or close friend of the client, a serious illness or accident affecting the client, or an emergency situation facing the client. In the event of postponing the retreat or cancelling the retreat, it will be the client's responsibility to communicate this to retreatants and to distribute the refund to retreatants as appropriate.

Agreements

In order to create a safe space for all beings, we ask guests to abide by the following guidelines:


- Practice non-harming and respect for the sanctity of all life: human, plant and animal.

Klipinnibos Nature Farm is set in a semi wilderness area. There are wild animals around and the hiking trail passes some high cliffs. Winter is fire season, and accidental wildfires are a risk. In summer we do have lightning and occasionally high winds during the year. Please use the venue and the larger farm environment with caution. The client shall take responsibility for the conduct and safety of their retreatants.

From Gauteng:

Take N12 to Emalahleni

Take N4 Middelburg

Continue on N4 to Machado Toll Plaza

2.5km after Toll Plaza slipway LEFT to Schoemanskloof.

45.9km to Weltevreden road.

Turn LEFT into Weltevreden road.

7.2km to T-junction.

Turn LEFT to Weltevreden.

6.7km and turn LEFT at KLIPINNIBOS signboard

850 meters then turn LEFT at KLIPINNIBOS signboard into a plantation road (if you reach a waterfall you have passed the turnoff and have to backtrack)

Drive 2.9km on this road (continuously keeping to the right on the most travelled road) until you reach KLIPINNIBOS Nature Farm.

SECOND GATE on the Left.
